An original bank statement from each Guarantor must be submitted to verify the amount of support to be provided. If the student has dependents that are coming to the United States, please note the breakdown on the Financial Statement Form.

 - Go to <u>www.ets.org/toefl</u> to register for test
 - Please enter our Institution Code number C332 for results to be sent to us.
- □ Transfer form is needed if transferring from another school within the U.S. You may obtain this form by contacting the Admissions Counselor at VC.

All documents must be received in office before an I-20 can be completed.

Admission to VC is determined by an objective evaluation of the applicant without regard to race, color, or ethnic origin in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

An I-20 form will be sent to accepted students. Please note that if you would like the I-20 to be sent through Fed-Ex or DHL, you will be responsible to make the payment where you live and set up a pickup at VC in the United States. VC does not cover the cost of shipping the package to you. Depending on where it is shipped to, this could cost approximately \$100. The prospective student will present the I-20 form to the United States Embassy in the country of his/her citizenship to apply for the F-1 student visa along with their receipt for the SEVIS Fee of \$350. A current student visa is required for all international students to enroll in VC. Acceptance into VC does not guarantee that the Consulate will grant you an F-1 student visa. Those who meet the criteria are approved by the U.S. Department of Justice, Immigration and Naturalization Service to enroll as international students.

Yearly tuition is \$4,000 plus a one-time International Enrollment fee of \$500. If you are in housing it is \$300 per month. You may pay for tuition upfront in full or break it up into 2 payments of \$2125. Once your Visa is approved and you are accepted to VC, at least one semester must be paid upfront. God Bless you. Victory College F-1 Student Immigration Responsibilities School of Ministry/Missions / School of Creative Arts

- 1. Attend the school that issued the 1-20 you used to enter the U.S. for at least 6 months prior to applying for transfer to another school. You must apply for a request to transfer with SEVIS.
- 2. Maintain a full course of study for the entire academic year. Successfully meet academic and financial responsibilities of school.
- 3. The International Student Advisor must grant written permission before you drop a class.
- 4. Maintain a valid passport at least 6 (six) months into the future.
- 5. Meet with the International Student Advisor at least 5 days before you plan to leave the U.S. for any reason. The Advisor must update your I-20 prior to your departure so you may re-enter the U.S.
- 6. Do not accept any off-campus employment unless you receive permission from immigration and through the International Advisor at Victory College.
- 7. If employed by Victory Church, you may work no more than 20 hours per week while school is in session and no more than 40 hours per week during an official school break.
- 8. You may apply as a volunteer in any capacity within the Ministry with required approval.
- 9. Notify the International Advisor of any change of address within 10 days of your move. You are also required to notify both SEVIS and Immigration. (see ISA for forms)
- 10. Your I-20 is your identification card in the U.S., you must carry either it with you at all times. (Your I-20 and your I-94 are your main validations that you have a legal right to be here.)
- 11. Copies of any license, certifications, change of status, tickets, fines, court judgments, or any other document that affects you must be provided to your International Student Advisor.
