

CHRISTIAN ETHICS & WORLDVIEW | THEO1211.VCO

A Christian perspective on the social decision-making process. Surveys both ancient and modern solutions to ethical issues.

JESUS AND THE GOSPELS | BIBL1103.VCO

This course is an in-depth study of the Gospels of the New Testament in relation to each other for the purpose of building personal faith and to develop a consistent framework of exegesis regarding the Gospels in their original context. This course will thoroughly explore the life and teachings of Christ and the themes and motifs of the Gospels.

PNEUMATOLOGY | THEO1210.VCO

Pneumatology is the study of God the Holy Spirit, the third Person of the Trinity. It answers numerous important questions about the Holy Spirit.

MINISTRY SEMINAR 2 | PRMI2420.VCO

This seminar is designed to provide students with information on a variety of ministry topics. Seminars will feature guest pastors and lecturers, as well as speakers from within Victory Church and its ministries.

PASTORAL MINISTRY | PRMI1304.VCO

This course is designed to provide students with a comprehensive understanding of the diverse responsibilities and roles encompassing pastoral ministry. Drawing upon the wisdom and expertise of experienced pastors, the course provides invaluable insights to enrich students' understanding of the pastoral profession.

INTRO TO WORLD RELIGIONS | MISS1205.VCO

The student will learn about the origins and major features of the leading non-Christian world religions, including Islam, Hinduism, Buddhism, and Judaism. The class also covers the major doctrinal differences between those belief systems and the Christian faith. A major emphasis of the course is to offer an apologetic approach to each major religion presented.

NEW TESTAMENT | BIBL1200.VCO

A study of the history and culture of the people and personalities of the early New Testament (Matthew to Acts). Attention is given to the timeline of events, chronological order, culture, major authors, and characters of the New Testament.

MISSIOLOGY 1 | MISS1104.VCO

This course will examine evangelism from both a practical and theological framework. Each student will have a chance to interact with the material and put into practice the information to be learned. The purpose of this course is to educate and engage students in evangelism & outreach both locally and globally.

MINISTRY PRACTICUM 2 | PRMI1510.VCO

This is an immersive course that offers students an opportunity to apply their theological education in a real-world church setting. In this hands-on practicum, students will engage with various facets of ministry at their local church. The experience aims to provide a comprehensive understanding of the daily operations and responsibilities within a dynamic church environment. Guided by experienced church leaders, students will also develop practical skills in leadership, communication, and problem-solving to prepare them for successful careers in ministry.
